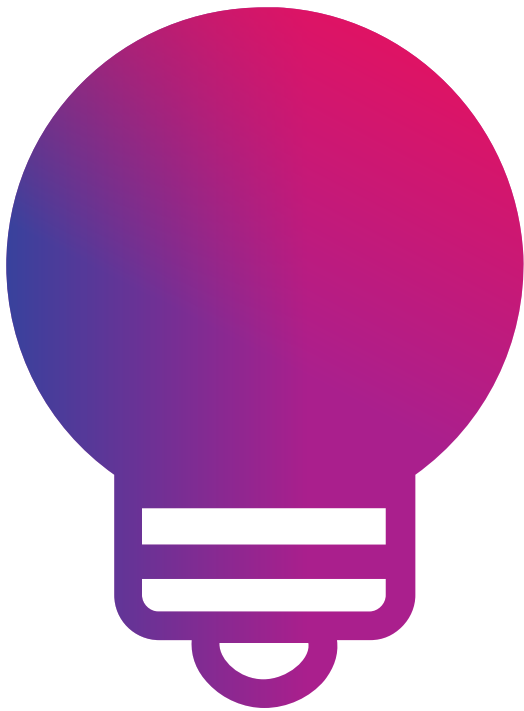
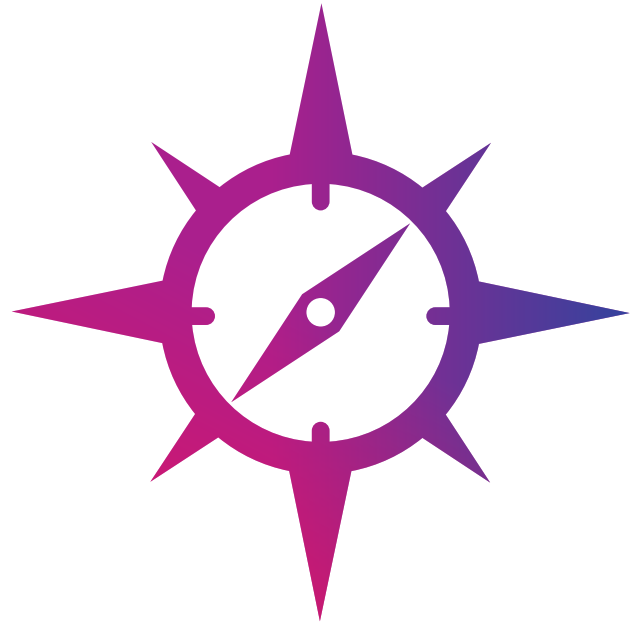

- **Write down or draw the different things that you find**

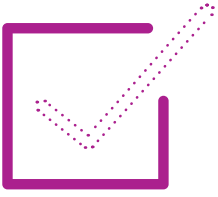

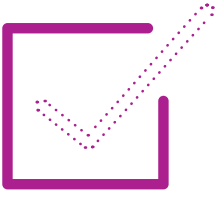

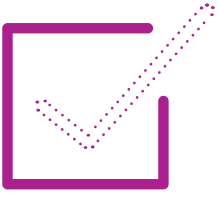

Three things that give off light

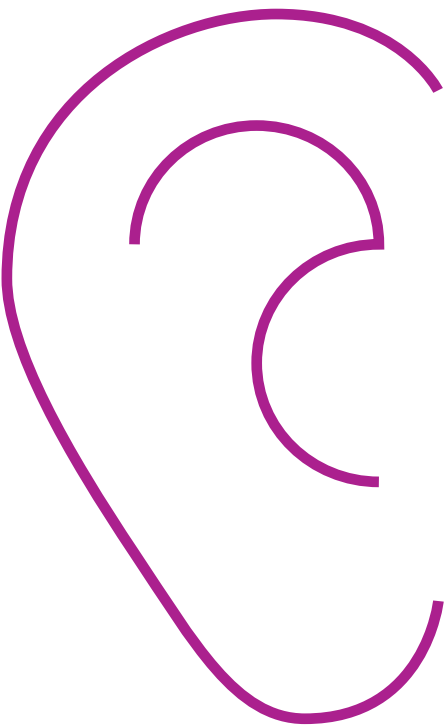


Three things that make a sound

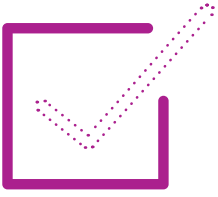
